- Emphasis on Core Subjects: Math, Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies
- Art: working with different media
- Citizenship and Community

Student Assessment and Testing

- Aligned with the Core California State Standards for Kindergarten
- Maintain regular, close communication with parents via email, Remind, and report cards
- Formal assessment in October and report cards in January and June
- Student file maintained and forwarded to the elementary school

7:30-8:30	Good morning! Indoor play inside of the village
8:30-9:30	Outdoor play time
9:30-10:00	Morning Snack
10:00-10:30	Whole group <ul style="list-style-type: none">● We do our morning greetings by saying Good Morning to our friends, pledge allegiance to our flag, and do calendar and weather activities. We sing our songs and finish by reading a book. We talk about the day's events and special happenings.
10:30-10:45	Language Arts & Writing <ul style="list-style-type: none">● During this time, we do our letters and participate in activities to develop phonological and phonemic awareness.
10:45-11:00	Math & Social Studies <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Students work in whole groups, small groups, or in teams using hands-on math manipulatives to learn math concepts.
11:00-11:30	1 on 1 time with teacher/Free play
11:30-12:00	Lunch
12:00-12:15	Reading Corner
12:00-1:15	Outdoor Recess
1:15-1:30	Read aloud or Meditation
1:30-1:45	Art or Science <ul style="list-style-type: none">● <u>Art</u>: Children will explore color, line, and form using different materials allowing them to make their own masterpiece. Art projects are always related to the weekly unit theme.● <u>Science</u>: We perform simple experiments using and discussing the scientific process.
1:45-2:00	Teacher directed activities



2:00-2:30	Independent Centers <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Students work independently in small groups at centers.● Centers:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Reading○ Math○ Writing○ Science○ Building○ Puzzle
2:30-3:00	Afternoon Snack
3:00-3:10	Clean up/ Pack up
3:10-3:40	Music & Movement/ Free play
3:40-4:40	Outdoor play
4:40-5:30	Clean up/Get ready to go home!



Jr. K/Kindergarten Curriculum

Reading:

- Recognizing and naming all uppercase and lowercase letters of the alphabet
- Matching all consonant and short vowel sounds to appropriate letters
- Blending vowel-consonant sounds orally to make words
- Distinguishing short vowel sounds orally state single syllable words
- Reading simple one syllable and high frequency words (sight words)

Writing:

- Writing first and last name
- Writing uppercase and lowercase letters of the alphabet independently
- Writing consonant-vowel-consonant (CVC) words and CCVC words

Mathematics:

- Counting numbers 0 to 100
- Counting, reading, and writing whole numbers to 100
- Writing 0 to 100
- Determining answers to addition and subtraction problems using picture cues
- Counting by 2's, 5's, and 10's to 100
- Telling time
- Addition with sums up to 10

Arts:

- Working with different tools
- Introduction to the basic elements of art

Science:

- Investigation and experimentation
- Observing and describing common objects using the 5 senses
- Communicating observations orally and through drawings
- Units will include: Oceans, Animals, Weather, Plants, Insects, and Butterflies

Spanish:

- Weekly with Spanish teacher from Lingo Train
